Rob Hindle is a long time volunteer with the Nepean City Soccer Club, including a 9 year term as President of the club. During his tenure, Rob's contributions led to a period of unprecedented growth, doubling the size of the club to 1800 players with over 110 teams. His contributions were felt both on and off the field. Rob helped develop the club's players as coach of many teams (including 3 competitive teams in one season!) and was also instrumental in developing young referees and establishing the Club's first Head Referee. Rob instructed coaching clinics, organized our House League festivals, handled equipment distribution and many, many other tasks that help keep a community soccer club running effectively.



One of his lasting contributions to the club and community will be his forethought and tireless work on developing soccer fields in cooperation with the city, schools and school boards that enabled accommodating the club's large increase in players.

Upon hearing of the nomination the NCSC Executive provided and his ultimate selection for the 2011 Ward 9 Volunteer Recognition Award (Sports and Recreation), Rob said, "I humbly thank all of you for this great honour. The true honour was and is seeing Nepean City Soccer, Ottawa's only youth only soccer club, grow and flourish.
